Highline Admission Requirements

International Student Application form

\$54 application fee

Bank statements showing at least US\$20,000 in funds

Copy of passport

Proof of English proficiency from the following options:

- ⇒ TOEFL score of 54 IBT
- ⇒ STEP-EIKEN: 2A
- ⇒ IELTS score of 5.5 in all sections
- ⇒ IGCSE Grade E or better in English
- ⇒ Completion of GCE A-level, O-level or N-level
- ⇒ Complete Kaplan High Intermediate Level
- ⇒ If you have studied in high school in English speaking countries or attended English speaking International School, this may be waived. Submit your school transcript to check the eligibility.
