Highline Admission Requirements

- International Student Application form
- \$54 application fee
- Bank statements showing at least US\$20,000 in funds
- Copy of passport
- Proof of English proficiency from the following options:
 - TOEFL score of 54 IBT
 - STEP-EIKEN: Pre-first grade
 - IELTS score of 5.5 in all sections
 - IGCSE Grade E or better in English
 - Completion of O level/N level or higher
 - Complete Kaplan High Intermediate Level
 - If you have studied in high school in English speaking countries or attended English speaking International School, this may be waived. Submit your school transcript to check the eligibility.
